




Project Benefit Distribution

Strategic project benefits





- Strategic initiatives creating energy efficiency & resilience
- In-kind support for projects that require expertise e.g. PPAs; ARENA feasibility studies



Local employment and procurement

- ~300 jobs across life of the project
- Engaging with Industry Capability Network for local suppliers where possible




Community Benefit Fund

- Grant funds delivered in partnership with community members, local councils & notfor-profit organisations
- Enabling multi-stakeholder and regional needs



Strategic project benefits




Beyond Compliance

- Potential to use infrastructure for telecomms
 - Land rehabilitation



Education and Training

- Scholarships & Apprenticeships
 - Training local people for employment post construction phase of project
 - Energy awareness and behaviour



Indigenous engagement

- Indigenous land use agreements
 - Employment on-country
 - Traditional Owner Renewable Energy Program in-kind assistance

Western Victoria transmission network project

Community Benefit Fund

- Majority of Fund accessed once project approvals are in place, however, a smaller tranche made available in Stage 1
- Fund available over ~3 years of project construction
- Applications made to the Fund each year; applications to be assessed by Advisory Group with representation from Community, AusNet & Councils
- Transparent process
